

National Space Centre PEEP Questionnaire for Disabled Persons

This questionnaire is intended to be completed by disabled persons to assist with the development of a Personal Emergency Evacuation Plan (PEEP). Please provide as much information as you can to enable the National Space Centre to develop a suitable plan.

Once developed, the PEEP will be used to assist escape in the event of an emergency.

Why you should fill in the form

The National Space Centre has a legal responsibility to protect you from fire risks and ensure your health and safety during your visit. The PEEP will be developed based on the information you provide.

What will happen when you have completed the form?

You will be provided with any additional information necessary about the emergency evacuation procedures in the buildings you attend.

If you need assistance, the Personal Emergency Evacuation Plan will specify what type of assistance you need.

- **1.** Which part of the National Space Centre will you go to see during your visit? *E.g., the Rocket Tower, Planetarium, Galleries*
- **2.** Are you aware of the emergency evacuation procedures in place at the National Space Centre?
- 3. Do you require written emergency evacuation procedures?
- **4.** Do you require written emergency evacuation procedures to be supported by British Sign Language interpretation?
- 5. Do you require the emergency evacuation procedures in Braille?
- **6.** Do you require the emergency evacuation procedures to be on tape or CD?
- 7. Do you require the emergency evacuation procedures to be in large print?
- **8.** Are the signs which mark emergency routes and exits at the National Space Centre clear and visible enough?
- **9.** Would you hear the fire alarm if it was triggered at the National Space Centre?

- 10. If you have difficulty in hearing the fire alarm, would a visual indicator assist?
- **11.** Do you need assistance to evacuate the building in the event of an emergency?
- **12.** Is anyone designated to assist you in an emergency?
 - **a.** If yes, please note their name(s)
- **13.** Is the arrangement with your assistant(s) a formal arrangement? (A formal arrangement is one specified for them by a senior person)
- **14.** Are you always in easy contact with those designated to help you?
- **15.** In the event of an emergency, could you contact the person in charge of evacuating the building and tell them where you were located?
- 16. Can you move quickly in the event of an emergency?
- **17.** Do you find stairs difficult to use?
- **18.** Are you a wheelchair user?
- **19.** Are you able to self-transfer to an evacuation chair if required?
- **20.** Could the medical nature of your disability be aggravated by the use of an evacuation chair?
- **21.** Please provide any additional information you feel is relevant.
