TETRASTAR SPACEPORT SAFETY INFORMATION

Space travel is not recommended for children under 5 years of age.

Passengers will experience strong vibrations, loud sounds, bright flashing lights and smoke effects.

Travelling with Tetrastar is a highly immersive experience which includes realistic moments of tension and mild peril.

The use of phones is not permitted during flight.

LAUNCH EXPERIENCE GUIDANCE

One area, which cannot be skipped includes a launch simulation with moving seats with the following guidance

- Please remain seated for the duration of the show
- Do not attempt to retrieve any items off the floor until the end of the show
- Seek assistance from your guide at the end of the show if any items have dropped behind the seat
- Do not share a seat with another person or sit on another person's lap
- After leaving the launch experience, some passengers may experience a mild form of disorientation.

The following people should not enter this experience:

- Pregnant Women
- Persons with Heart or Back problems
- Persons with recent surgery or existing conditions that will be affected
- Persons with any other physical condition that may mean it is unsafe to sit in a moving seat

Height Restrictions

- Children under 1.2m must be accompanied by an adult
- Minimum height 1.0m
